КОНСПЕКТ УРОКА АНГЛИЙСКОГО ЯЗЫКА ПО TEME «CHRISTMAS DAY»

Тип урока: Изучение нового материала.

Цель урока: ознакомить учащихся с обычаями и традициями празднования этого дня в англоязычных странах.

Задачи:

- 1) воспитательная: воспитание у учащихся чувства уважения к истории и культуре страны изучаемого языка;
- 2) обучающая: развитие лексических навыков;
- 3) развивающая: развитие познавательных интересов учащихся.

Оборудование: компьютер и мультимедийный проектор с экраном, магнитофон.

Ход урока.

- 1. Организационный момент.
- T: Hello, boys and girls. I'm glad to see you. Today is the 25 of October and people in different countries celebrate one holiday. What holiday is it?
- P: It's Christmas day.
- T: Yes, you are right. And today we will have an unusual lesson. (1 слайд)
- 2. First, let's warm up. Ученики слушают и повторяют за учителем хором.
- 3. General Part.
- (2 слайд) Teacher: Christmas Day, December 25, is probably the most popular holiday in Great Britain.
- (3 слайд) Christmas Day, December 25, is probably the most popular holiday in Great Britain.
- (4 слайд) It is a family holiday. Traditionally all relatives and friends give each other presents. So, before Christmas all the department stores and shops are crowded, everybody is choosing a present.
- (5 слайд) In general, people get prepared for this holiday very carefully. They decorate their houses in the traditional way. Christmas trees are set up in houses, in the streets and churches. They are always decorated with fairy lights, angels and small toys. In addition, little packets with nuts, candies and special biscuits are hung on the tree. Presents are put around the tree and artificial «frost» is scattered over the branches.
- (6 слайд) Besides the Christmas tree, holly and mistletoe are used to decorate the house. berry from the mistletoe. It is said that the girl who was not kissed under it at Christmas would not get married that year.

(7 слайд) Besides the Christmas tree, holly and mistletoe are used to decorate the house. Branches of holly are put up behind pictures and mistletoe is hung over doors, so the young people have a chance to kiss the girls under it, plucking each time a red berry from the mistletoe. It is said that the girl who was not kissed under it at Christmas would not get married that year.

(8 слайд) Santa Claus got his name from a man known as St. Nicolas, who lived in the fourth century. He gave his wealth to the poor and often to children. After he died, the Dutch brought this legend to colonial America. Soon the Dutch name Sinter Klaus became Santa Claus.

(9 слайд) Carol singing is an essential part of Christmas. No church or school is without its carol service. Carols may be traditional or with some variations that express different feelings. Carols were used for the first time during Christmas in the fifteenth century.

Usually children come around in the evening to the front doors and start singing carols and people who live in these houses give children candies, nuts, pies and so on, to thank them for carol singing.

- (10 слайд) A typical Christmas lunch includes turkey with cranberry sauce and pudding. Every young woman in each household helps to stir the Christmas pudding, if she wishes to be married that year. Usually a coin or two are hidden inside the pudding and part of the fun is to see who finds it.
- 4. Физкультминутка. Stand up, boys and girls and remember our exercises.
- (11 слайд) One of the ancient British traditions Christmas log. It is believed that the ancient Vikings brought this rite in England. At Christmas, they sawed down a huge tree, and it is stored for the whole year dried up. Until the next Christmas he was brought into the house, and it burned in the hearth for a long time. If faded, not burned to ashes, the hosts were expecting trouble.

(12 слайд) After the lunch they go to the sitting room to listen to the Christmas speech of the Queen, shown on TV.


So, Christmas is a merry family holiday for all the people of Great Britain. Christmas comes but once a year.
