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КОНСПЕКТ ВНЕКЛАССНОГО МЕРОПРИЯТИЯ ДЛЯ ПРОВЕДЕНИЯ В 6 КЛАССЕ: «ПЛАНЕТА ЖИВОТНЫХ»

Задачи: Привитие интереса к изучению английского языка.

Развитие любознательности, ответственности, культуры общения на английском языке.

5, 4, 3, 2, 1....MUSIC. Звучит музыка.

Учитель: Dear friends, we're glad to see you here at our programme "ANIMAL PLANET". There are 3 teams today: "SHARKS", "JAGUARS", and "DOLPHINS".

They'll say their greetings now:

We are SHARKS. Our motto is-TWO WRONGS DO NOT MAKE A RIGHT.

We are JAGUARS. Our motto is- EVERY CLOUD HAS A SILVER LINING.

We are DOLPHINS. Our motto is- FOUR EYES SEE MORE THAN TWO.

Look, children! I've got a lot of stars. Your answers will be evaluated. One right answer- one star. Are you ready?

1. Now the first contest is to answer my question: WHY DO PEOPLE LIKE ANIMALS? One after another, please, beginning with the team.....Use opinion words!....Well done, thank you.

2. And now listen to me very attentively. It's not a question; it's a fact- SOME PEOPLE HATE ANIMALS. Do you agree or disagree with me? Am I right or not?

In my opinion a lot of people like animals and we can add that animals are our friends, especially when we enjoy having a pet at home or watching some animals in nature parks or zoos. One of the most popular parts of any zoo is the dolphinarium. Here spectators can watch the dolphins swimming underwater, and performing tricks. A team of workers is responsible for looking after dolphins and training them to do tricks.

This task looks at a day in the life of a dolphin trainer, Joe Trounson, who used to work with the dolphins in a nature park in England. I've prepared some words and now try to use these words describing his working day.

- **3.** It's time for our game'' GUESS THE ANIMAL''. Our Sharks, Dolphins and Jaguars have prepared these nice boxes. In these boxes we'll find the names of the animals. Let's guess them! Ask questions about these animals, using DOES,CAN,IS,HAS.
- **4.** Our fourth contest is to describe one of your favourite animals. Be ready and while our children are thinking over their tasks I'll give the task for you, our spectators: Guess these animals!

I think it wasn't very difficult for you. Our spectators are great!

5. We can't imagine our life without advertisements. It's time for it now. Let's watch it. Children! Remember the names of the animals. Those children are afraid of them.

Let's continue our programme! What animals are those children afraid of? What about you?

Many children keep pets, and though dogs, cats, hamsters and goldfish are as popular as ever there is a trend for children to keep more unusual pets. They are nasty pets. What revolting pets do you know?

Look, this is a worm!

- 1. Do worms live in the ground?
- 2. When do they come out?
- 3. Do you like worms?

Who's this? It's a cockroach!

- 1. What do they eat?
- 2. Where do they live?
- 3. When do they sleep?
- 4. Where do they look for food?
- 5. Do they like bright lights?

Look! It's a spider!

- 1. What room do they live in?
- 2. Where do red back spiders live?
- 3. Can they have a bite or kill?
- 4. Do they make good pets?
- 5. Do they live in Russia?
- 6. Do spiders live in our classroom?

Yes, look there's a spider on the floor. (A SONG "THERE'S A SPIDER OH THE FLOOR, ON THE FLOOR")

6. Boys and girls, I've got a surprise for you. It's a name of the animal. But I'm afraid of spiders. (the letters are falling and mixing). Where are my letters? What animal is it?

It's a CHIMPANZEE. You know some facts about chimps. Listen! Are these sentences FALSE or TRUE?

- 1. A baby chimpanzee can walk.
- 2. Chimps often swim.
- 3. Chimps build their nests quickly.
- 4. Chimps can go to the dentists.
- 5. Chimps can weigh up to 10 kilos.
- 6. Chimps live in zoos.

Have you ever seen chimps in zoos? Yes, you have. Aren't they funny and amusing?

7. Now I'll give you the next task. It is connected with the zoo.

This sentence begins with AT THE ZOO THERE ARE SOME....In groups, let's play this memory game! Each player has to repeat everything in the list and then add a new item. If a player makes a mistake, the team will be out of game. Be creative! Not just to say the name of an animal, but to give an adjective or two as well. For example, not just "a spider", but "six nasty black spiders".

8. Children, yesterday I was very surprised! Why? I received a letter from the country, which is called ABRA CADABRA.

Have you ever heard about this country? But this letter is for our programme" Animal Planet". I couldn't understand some sentences, I think they don't know English well. There are some mistakes in this letter. Help me, please, I've chosen these sentences, correct them!

- 1. Our zoo is closed in Mondays.
- 2. Lions doesn't live in Abra Cadabra.
- 3. How often you go to the zoo?
- 4. You can to visit our country.
- 5. We hasn't got penguins.
- 6. What penguins eat?

- 7. Our cats drinks milk
- 8. Sharks can fly?

I think it would be better to write our answer to them.

9. And now there is our last contest. Our teams are ready with their CROSSWORDS. Show me, them, please. I'll give you these crosswords and during guessing the words speak only English, if you speak Russian, you'll miss one star for one Russian word.

Children, give me your stars, I'll count them. It's time to finish our programme. We think you like it!
